Needle Holder Nell is made using all the different straight stitches you have just learned. She's also really useful to have, as you can keep all your needles inside her!

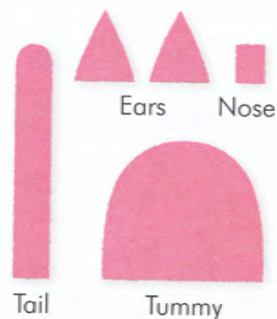
Get stitching!



Making Nell

To make Nell, you will need to use the templates on page 75.

Pin the templates to the felt and carefully cut around them (see page 12). Ask someone to help you cut them out.



Body front



Body back

You will need

- Red felt for Nell's body
- Pink felt for Nell's tummy, nose, ears and tail
- White, yellow and black thread ● One needle

Stitching Nell's body

- 1 Stitch Nell's tummy to her body with one big white cross stitch in the middle (see page 28), and some yellow running stitches around the edge.
- 2 Stitch white cross stitches around her tummy.
- 3 Stitch her nose to her body with a black cross stitch.
- 4 Stitch three black running stitches (see page 19) for her whiskers on each side of her nose (pull back her nose a little to start each whisker). Stitch three black running stitches for both of her eyes and her mouth.

Putting Nell together

- 5 Put Nell's front and back body pieces together so that all the edges match. Stitch her ears through both her front and back with a black cross stitch.

- 6 Turn Nell over and stitch her tail to her back with three black cross stitches – be careful not to stitch it to her front!



Make Nell some friends!

You can make Nell some friends by using different-coloured felt and thread.
